



1° National Pizza Championship

Dublin, 4-5 February 2020

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competitors must be at least sixteen (16) years of age at the time of competing in the National Pizza Championship.
2. In order to compete in the Championship, participants must fill out the Registration Form and send it back, with a copy of their personal ID, to info@apiireland.ie or Suite 210, 4/5 Burton Hall Road, Sandyford, Dublin 18, by 31st of January 2020. Failure to meet these criteria may result in denial of participation.
3. Registration will be confirmed and valid upon receipt of payment of an Entry Fee of € 100.00. Payment can be made by Bank Transfer to: API Association of Pizzerias Ireland Ltd – IBAN: IE94 BOFI 9061 6082 6722 13 – BIC: BOFIE2D.
4. During the competition, participants are required to wear the uniform provided by the organization.
5. Competitors will have the opportunity to choose between using a wood-fired or an electric oven. Participants must indicate their preference in the Registration Form.
6. Each competitor will have to bring and use their own products. The organization will only provide the tools of normal use.
7. At the start of their competition, the contestant will prepare his pizza, cook it, and show it to the judges in a pizza dish or tray.
8. At the end of their turn, each contestant is required to clean up their workstation, failing to do so will result in their immediate disqualification.
9. It's strictly forbidden to offer gifts of any kind to the jury, under penalty of immediate disqualification.
10. The judges will assign a score ranging from 30 to 100 points for each of the required categories. The votes of the Jury of Taste (max 2000) and the Oven Jury (max 300) will be added together and the total, which can reach a maximum of 2300 points, will determine the ranking position.
JURY OF TASTE
The Jury of Taste is composed of 5 judges, each of which will give a maximum score of 100 points for each of the following categories: 1) Pairing of Ingredients 2) Flavour 3) Cooking 4) Structure and Crunchiness; for a maximum score of 2000 points.
OVEN JURY
The Oven Jury is composed of a single judge, who will give a maximum score of 100 points for each of the following categories: 1) Preparation 2) Stretching and Dressing 3) Cleanliness; for a maximum score of 300 points.
11. The Jury's judgment is final and not subject to appeal. The winner and final scores will be announced at the end of the competition on Wednesday, 5th February 2020.
12. The organization reserves all advertising rights and use of photographic material related to the event.
